 And the said negro Girl Maria and her future issue are conveyed upon this express
 condition among others that they are in no event and under no circumstances to
 the said child or subject to the debts or contracts of her present or any future husband
 hereafter contracted or incurred And the profits arising from the
 labor of the said Maria or her issue shall likewise under no circumstances and
 in no event be liable or subject to the debts or contracts of the present or any fu-
 ture husband of my daughter Nancy C. Clark And I do hereby warrant the
 title of the said negro Girl Maria unto Thomas J. Roberts as Trustee as aforesaid
 for the use and purposes herein expressed
