That I Henry Morgan of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars to me paid by James Gallen of the same State and District have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James Gallen aforesaid a certain Tract or parcel of Land situated in the District of Greenville on the south side of Sundry Creek waters of Reedy River commencing on a Maple running Thence N 28 E 450 to a black oak Thence N 60 E 175 to a Stake Thence S 27 E 18.50 to a black oak Thence 70 W 17 to a spruce on the Creek Thence up the meander of said Creek to the beginning containing Twenty three and one eighth Acres bounded by S by M. Bess lands by 4 1/2 M. W. Tenny

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said James Gallen his heirs and assigns And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said James Gallen his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs Executors administrators or assigns and against all and singular the claims of every other person a person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
