 that we Shadrach Crane and John Will of the

District and State aforesaid from this day made a division of that tract or parcel of land which we have decided to use for Charles J. Thompson situated in the District and State aforesaid in the Sixth Hole Fork of Sixa River and Morgans Creek and bounded by lands belonging to Little, Puck and others Also hereby relinquish to each other all rights titles interest and claims in the separate parcels or lots of said lands Namely I Shadrach Crane hereby relinquish unto the said John Will all my right title interest and claim in that parcel or lot No 2 containing Two hundred and Thirteen Acres more or less beginning in a Stone on the bank of said river and running up the River to the meanders to the mouth of a branch at the Rutherford road Thence up the said river with the meanders to a White oak 37 Thence N 60 E 32,00 to Stake Thence N 10 W 5,50 to Stake 4 Thence North 15,90 to Passimman 37 37 on Creek near Poplar dead Thence down said Creek with meanders to the river Thence up the River to a Stone Thence West 20 to a Stone Thence S 1 E 7,50 to the beginning

Together with all and singular the rights memory hereunto appertaining and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appurtenant And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators or assigns to relinquish all rights titles interest and claims in said Lot of Land No 2 unto the said John Will and assigns forever
