sum of Nine Hundred Dollars to us paid by James Clun bar of the aforesaid State and District the receipt whereof we do truly acknowledge we do truly give grant bargain and convey and of these presents have given granted sold and conveyed unto the said James Clun bar his heirs and assigns all that Tract or parcel of Land Situate in the said District aforesaid on the South branch of Headwaters Creek being a part of the Tract of Land originally granted to John Peden containing 244 Acres and more in Grant Book C C C C Page 310 Granted on the first day of August 1788 being on a Black Walnut 57 1/2 acres one of the original Post oak corners Thence N 15 1/2 W 21.50 to a Red oak 57 Thence S 75 W 11.4 to a Black Walnut originally a Post oak corner Thence N 15 1/2 W 23.30 to a Red oak 57 on the original line Thence S 15 E 5.20 to a White oak 57 Thence S 86 E 40 to a Rock Station Thence to a Post oak 57 Thence to the Station and to the Beginning including the houses and plantation containing One Hundred and Forty acres of Land to the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said James Clun bar his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever And we the said Miles Wash and Mary Wash jointly for ourselves and our heirs Executors and Administrators covenant with the said James Clun bar his heirs and assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforesaid premises and that they are free of all incumbrances that we have good right to sell and convey the same unto the said James Clun bar And that we our heirs Executors and assigns will warrant and defend the same premises unto the said James Clun bar his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whatsoever
