Tarrant of the State and District aforesaid do hereby certify that I have granted, bargained and sold by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto C. G. Garrison a parcel of Land containing Five Acres more or less and lying on the western side of Saluda River beginning on a Rock oak corner on William Means Land Thence N 70° W along said William Means line to a rock corner now made on C. G. Garrison land from thence N 70° E along said C. G. Garrison line to the beginning Rock oak being a part of a Tract known as the Wilson Tract lying on the side of the Wilson Bridge Head. I give this with all and singular thoughts, intents, covenants and appurtenances to the premises hereinafter in any wise incident or appertaining. I have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the C. G. Garrison his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever and forever defend the said premises unto the said C. G. Garrison his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and persons whomsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 19th day of December 1831. Thence eight hundred and fifty within the Seventy fifth Year of the Independence of the United States of America.
