do hereby warrant and forever defend premises against myself my heirs and assigns executors administrators and any other person claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof this the 15th December 1851

beginning at the water of Tyger adjoining Noah Dallen and Joshua Dallen containing forty one acres more or less beginning at Noah Dallen beginning corner Chestnut Iron Mine. Then to a Chestnut Iron Mine to a pine or conditional line then to a rock corner on the banks of the creek then down the bank to Noah Dallen line then up the branch ditch to a persimmon tree then to a Mulberry on Noah Dallen line then to a Chestnut near the head of a Spring then to the beginning corner for one acre or less of the same then to a Mulberry and fifty Mulberries and I Jacob Dallen do hereby warrant and forever defend premises against myself my heirs and assigns executors administrators and any other person claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof this the 15th December 1851
