Five Dollars to me paid by Elijah Dalling in the State aforesaid have granted bargain sold and released and by this present do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Elijah Dalling All That Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on the North side of Prehaute Creeks of South Upper River beginning at a White Oak 3737 on the banks of said Creeks and runs N 33 E 42 77 to a Stone 34 Thence N 55 26 45 to a post Oak 3738 Thence S 87 44 27 35 to a Post Oak 3737 on the North side of said Creeks Thence down Prehaute Creeks to the beginning containing Forty Three Acres the same more or less bounded by Lands belonging to Thomas Walden, William Dalling and others

To gether with all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Elijah Dalling his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defende all and singular the said Premises unto the said Elijah Dalling his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
