but oak corner Thence a conditional line to a White oak corner Thence a
conditional line to a Red oak corner on Bradleys back line Thence near a Month
over to a Red oak corner Thence with a conditional line between Robert Martin
(George Evans to a peach Tree stump) in the old field near the branch Thence
that I also own said branch to the beginning corner.

To have and to hold all and singular the said
land and property unto the said Martin Hunt for his uses and apparel and to him
