Then solemnly these presents That I Jane Ashmore
 of Ashmore in the County of Guilford District in the State of North Carolina
 of our life and in consideration of a certain sum of money
 I did give the sum of Two Thousand and a hundred

day executed and delivered to me by my son Thomas P Ashmore and another
 for my support and maintenance by the said Thomas P Ashmore for and during
 the Term of my natural life and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred
 by the said Thomas P Ashmore to me in hand paid at and before the
 making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
 when he gained, and sold and by these presents do he again sell and deliver
 to the said Thomas P Ashmore, My two negro slaves, viz. Bob aged about
 thirty five years and Clarius aged about fourteen years.

To have and to hold the said negro slaves, Bob and Clarius
 unto the said Thomas P Ashmore his Executors, Administrators and assigns
 to them and his only proper use and behoof forever

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
 on the 2^d day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 two and in the 7th year of the Independence of the United States of America

 of J. P. Week and M. Gill Jane P Ashmore
