The State of South Carolina against John Maxwell and Elizabeth his wife Robert A. Maxwell and Mary his wife Dr. John W. Lewis and Maria his wife Mrs. D. M. May, Elias Earle and his six children namely Francis H. Mary R. William R. Minam D. Elias P. and Florence S. Earle and pray that the defendants be decreed to execute a bill to the State as stated in the bill was made fairly and for a sufficient price, to wit for said Thomas one thousand dollars payable in three equal instalments the first of which was due the 20th of December 1850. The second the 20th of December 1851 and the third the 20th of December 1852. It is therefore upon motion of the complainant Solicitor General that the plaintiff do enter into bond to the Commissioner of this Court with at least two good securities for the payment of the said price in the said instalments (upon which bond such parts of the price as has been paid shall be credited with such indorsement as will show to the satisfaction of the distributees the said payments have been made and upon such bond being entered the defendants do convey the said Land, to the Plaintiff in fee with full release of warranty, release of incumbrances (the instruments to be approved by the Commissioner) subject to appeal and that the Commissioner do convey on behalf of the infant defendants that the Commissioner do collect the said Bond and distribute the proceeds according to the legal Rights of the parties. Also orders that the parties be at liberty to apply for any order necessary in the case. The order to be paid out of the assets of the intestate Edward H. Earle by his Administrator. Now know all men by these presents that we John Maxwell and Elizabeth his wife Robert A. Maxwell and Mary his wife John W. Lewis and Maria his wife D. M. May and Elias Earle and Samuel A. Jones Commissioners in and for the Greenville District for and in behalf of Francis H. Mary R. William R. Minam D. Elias P. and Florence S. Earle the minor children of Elias Earle for and consideration of the sum of Twelve Thousand and Hundred dollars to us in hand paid or secured to be paid by Samuel W. Earle the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged for Have Grants Bargains, Release, Sell and Convey and by these presents do Grant Bargain, release, Sell and Convey unto the said Samuel W. Earle his heirs and assigns forever all the Tracts and parcels of Land herein described (viz) Tract No 1 situated lying and being in the District of Greenville in the State of South Carolina beginning at a Sycamore on the North Bank of the South Fork of Saluda and running thence N 70° W 26.50 to a cherry tree 34 Thence N 50° E 115.50 to a Hickory 37 Thence N 46° E 47.50 to a small oak 34 Thence S 56° E 141.70 to a Stake 34 Thence S 21° W 22.25 to a Stake 34 Thence S 70° E 70.50 across the South Fork of Saluda to a Stake 34 Thence S 20° W 100 to a Chestnut oak 34 Thence South 89° E 18.50 to a Stake 34 Thence S 45° W 19.80 to Chestnut Oak 34 Thence S 75° W 13 to a poplar 34 Thence S 85° W 13 to a Stake in the head of a branch 34 Thence down said branch to its mouth 34 and thence up the meanders of the South Fork of Saluda to the beginning Sycamore.
