The Pres ^t Director of B of State vs James Odum	Dec ^r 31 st 1835 313 paces	The State of South Carolina Know all men by these Presents that The President and Directors of the Bank of the State of South Carolina in consideration of Ten Hundred and forty Dollars to us paid by James Odum of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina The President and Directors of the Bank of the State of South Carolina, have granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James Odum a parcel or Tract of Land containing Two hundred and Thirteen and one fourth acres by a survey made by James S. McQueen on the 4 th day of December 1831 and originally granted to Thomas L. Gore on the 5 th day of March 1787 lying and being in Greenville District on a branch Fortmoberny Branch Run of Middle Tyger River and a small branch of Elisha Thompsons Branch Run and conveyed by Deed to Mackley and by the Sheriff of Greenville District to the President and Directors of the Bank of the State of South Carolina Dated and bounded as follows Beginning on a Pine adjoining Milton Pender Land runs South 36 ^o 44' 44" East to Stake Stephen Dills Land Thence 53 ^o 40' 46" East 38 to a Stone corner Thence West 62 ^o 70' North Eighteen Stakes on Mary McMechins Land Thence South 53 ^o 46' 04" 38 East to the beginning containing Two hundred and Thirteen and one fourth Acres (more or less) Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditary and appurtenances to the said premises Challenging a in any wise incident or appurtenance To have and to hold all and singular the premises before times unto the said James Odum his heirs and assigns forever And he hereby binds the said Bank to warrant and defend all and singular
