To have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid to the said Rev Samuel Johnson his heirs and assigns forever in trust for the sole and separate use of the said Susan Taylor as a home and place of residence for herself and the children above mentioned for and during the natural life and after the death to and for the use of the children herein above named and next thereof I do hereby signify my full power and administration to warrant and forever defend the said premises to the said Rev Samuel Johnson his heirs and assigns forever in trust for the use above mentioned against the claim myself or any heirs and every other person whatsoever lawfully claiming to claim the same or any part thereof
