

To a stake thereof is 624, 625, 626 to a small gum 34 near stone 517 1/2
to 1.25 to the beginning, containing thirteen and a half acres the
same more or less.

Together with all and singular the rights premises hereunto and
appertinances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises
before mentioned unto the said Thomas Taylor his heirs and assigns
forever. I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
unto said Thomas Taylor his heirs and assigns against myself my
heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming
the same in any part thereof.
