of his death I do covenant with the said P. Pool that I am one of the heirs
of the said James Hodgin and have an interest in the said Tract a part
of land and have a right to convey my interest to the same and that the same
unincumbered I do further covenant and bind myself my heirs and Representatives
to warrant and forever defend the title to the said Tract every part thereof
to the said P. Pool his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons
whatsoever this 3^d day of May A^d 1855
