Willingham of Spartanburg District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Alfred Taylor have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Alfred Taylor all that tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on branches of Pines Creek waters of Ennore river containing one hundred and seventy seven acres more or less beginning at a Red Oak 38 m Y. N. Kings corner running S 38. E 56. 75 chs to the Blue corn be wood thence up the meander of said road about forty one chains to a point in the middle of said road on Cleveland's line thence with said line S 73 3/4 W 25 23 chs to a stake thence S 30 3/4 E 54.00 chs to the beginning together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Alfred Taylor his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Taylor his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
