H. Snow of the same State and District I Charles Quarter Bargainer and sold and by these presents do Grant, bargain sell and relinquish unto the said J. H. Snow all that Tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the State and District aforesaid being part of a Grant originally Granted to Benjamin Nitgers Jun by Patent bearing date the 5<sup>th</sup> day of September 1792 Recorded in Grant Book C No 5 Page 149 on a branch of Enoree River where Eli C Sheppard formerly lived and where the said J. H. Snow now resides Beginning on a corner marked 34 on the branch on James S Parris land and running up the middle of the branch to a large Spanish Oak 34 Thence S 83 W 9.25 to a Hickory 34 on the north Thence on the Road to a Stake 34 Thence S 32 W 21.75 to a Stake, Thence to a P.
