

in specie which is now sanctioned by the parties. She received five hundred dollars for her claim to the tract of land known as the Fox Track mentioned in the marriage contract which she retains. She has received the rent corn on the said tract of land during the past year which he is to have. The said Parton is also to have the present stock of provisions, corn and provisions on the home place at this time provided the said Rebecca Parton does not continue to reside on the said place. If she continues to live there all the said stock of provisions corn, fodder and so forth are to be hers.

In consideration of the above enumerated property which come by Mrs Rebecca Parton at her marriage with the said William Parton and which property the said William Parton is to have and retain as his own future. The the said William Parton gives up and by this presents relinquishes and will do so more expressly to Colm Benjamin Haggard in a separate deed as Trustee for Mrs Parton all other interests which she now has or may hereafter have in and under all the other property which hereafter Mrs Rebecca Parton purchases to the marriage with him and also all interest which she may have in and under the marriage settlement made between him and his said wife Rebecca Parton at their marriage with above specified.

Mrs Rebecca Parton on her part is to receive through the Trustee Colm Benjamin Haggard immediately from her husband Colm William Parton the following property which is to be secured to her and her heirs forever, exclusive of the said husband (viz) The Home place on which she now lives and which was purchased by her at the division of Higginson's Estate on Ferris Creek within of Saluda River bounded by lands of James Hoggins, Alfred Cantrell and others the following negro Slaves David, Vera, Tom, Armstrong, Charles, and Harriet and their increase the household and kitchen furniture, stock of all kinds, cattle, horses and hogs. The cattle and hogs are to be made the same in number that were on the place at the marriage of the parties. The horses are to be made of the same value as when the marriage took place. The said Rebecca Parton is to retain all her notes and moneys which she had at the inter marriage with the said Colm William Parton and which have not been reduced to her possession. The stock of provision already mentioned as being on the home place is to be the said Rebecca Parton provided she continues to live there otherwise to be Colm William Parton.

In consideration of the above property which is to be conveyed to Mrs Parton Trustee Colm Benjamin Haggard for her sole use and benefit she relinquishes all claim on the said husband William Parton for any support or alimony from him and also all claim or interest whatsoever which she may have in his estate or property or the property which he the said William Parton now retains or has received of her she also relinquishes all claims which she has under the marriage contract between her and the said husband inconsistent with this agreement. In the case of the death of Colm William Parton before her she the said Rebecca is not to disturb or claim the property now devised by the said Colm William Parton and in as much as she is a feme covert and cannot legally make a contract in law she is to procure the letters of administration
