Whereas James M Doock et al, on or about the day of _____ in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two, exhibited their Bill of Complaint, in the Court of Equity at Greenville C. D., in the said State against Green Co et al. And the cause being at issue before the honorable Court came on to be heard at July term, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty four, when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises, did order Judgment, and Decree, that the Lands described in said Bill should be sold at Public auction, by the commissioner of said Court, on the terms, and for the purposes mentioned in said Decretal order, as by reference thereto in the registry of said Court will appear; And the said Samuel A Townes as commissioner of said Court, after having duly advertised the said Land, for sale by public outcry, on the sixth of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and 54, did then openly and publicly and according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the said Land below described unto the said John Garmary for certain hundred and five Dollars
