more or less originally granted to David Morton Deed, by his Executor
of Benjamin Gerard the twenty first day of January 1785 situated
in Greenville District & State aforesaid and in the South fork of Raven
creek. Beginning on a Post oak on John Pedens corner N 15 E 1/4
Ped oak S, S 75 W 1/4 S, thence to a pine S, thence to a Post oak N 15
W 1/4 S, thence to the beginning.
