Know all men by these presents that I Palas C Jordane of the State and Dis

trict aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Micajah Jordane of the same place have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Micajah Jordane all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred acres (more or less) situate and lying in the District and State aforesaid on Saluda river beginning on a Bucke $\frac{3}{4}$ on the river and running thence N 49 E 43, 75 to a small Hickory bounded by Jesse Dancher, thence N 19 W 11 to a small Hickory $\frac{3}{4}$, thence S 82 W 12, 50 to a Black Gum $\frac{3}{4}$ on the river bounded by Martino Stone, thence down the meanders of said river to the beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights and here hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Micajah Jordane his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defende all and singular the said premises unto the said Micajah Jordane his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
