Fowler of the State and district aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty dollars to me in hand paid by Hamilton Johnson of the State and District aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge I have granted, bargained, sold, and released unto the said Hamilton Johnson a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being situate in Greenville District and State aforesaid, upon Wolf Creek waters of the Middle Fork of Saluda river Beginning upon a post Oak, thence S 20° W to a pine, thence the same course to a Black Gum thence S 40° E to a Persimmon more thence S 30° E to a chestnut, thence N 17° W to a Red Oak, thence to the beginning corner, by estimation one
