

Cobb McKeay Deeds
To [] for
John Campbell Land

This Indenture made this Fifteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty five between Robert McKeay, Ordinary of the District aforesaid, and John Campbell of the same State and District.

Whereas a writ of summons to divide or sell a certain tract of lands hereinafter described of the Estate of Sarah Hill of said District, deceased, issued from the Court of Ordinary of said District and upon the return thereof, the Judge of said Court did determine that the said Land could not be divided without injury to the parties interested, and did order the same to be sold by the Sheriff of the District aforesaid on a credit of Twelve months with Interest from date.

Whereupon the Sheriff aforesaid, did advertise the said Land for sale on the first Monday in February in the above mentioned. And whereas, the Sheriff aforesaid did on the said day expose to sale at public outcry, on the credit aforesaid, the said Land when the said John Campbell was the last, and highest bidder, to whom the said Land was struck off for the sum of Five Hundred and seventy five dollars.

Now this indenture witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and seventy five Dollars, to me paid and secured to be paid, I have granted bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargained sell and release, unto the said John Campbell and his heirs and assigns forever all that tract of Land situated in said District on Blasingames Mill Creek, one of the waters of Middle Tyger River containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less, adjoining lands of Amos Langley, Calvin Farmer James Wilson and others, being the same Land conveyed by Edwards Hill to Sarah Hill by Deeds bearing date the 30th day of June 18th 1820, and bounded as follows.

Beginning at a chestnut Blasingames corner, thence with his line N 63^o West 110^o 50^o L to a Hickory, thence S 22^o W 100^o 50^o L to a pine, thence S 35^o W 140^o L to a Post Oak, thence N 75^o W 40^o che to a Hickory, thence N 30^o W 20^o che to a stake one John sons line, thence with his line N 7^o 45^o che 50^o L to a P. O. near the Jugate Road, thence N 82^o E along the Road 19^o che 38^o L to a chestnut, thence N 69^o E 15^o che to a P. O. thence N 50^o E 7^o che to a Gum bush, near the Creek, thence N 70^o E 10^o che to a Post O, thence S 45^o E to the beginning
