appeared before me in consideration of a comfortable maintenance granted to me as long as I may live and also for the sum of one dollar to me in hand paid upon the delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged with release and acquittance and by these presents do release and forever quit claim unto the Heirs of my body and to their assigns all the estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever in law or equity or otherwise however of in or to or out of all that tract of land lying in Guinean District in the State of South Carolina on Waters of Dusty Creek which are waters of Enore River adjoining lands of William Morris, Holtzclaw, Henderson and others containing Three hundred and eighty two acres be the same more or less the same being land left to me for my life by my husband Henry Harris to hold the same to them and their Heirs or assigns forever against me or any holding under me
