Ely of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina in consideration of one thousand dollars to me paid by Alexander Greenfield of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina have granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents do Grant Bargain sell and Release unto the said Alexander Greenfield all that piece parcel and lot of Land situate lying and being in the Town of Greenville in the District and State aforesaid upon the west side of Richardson Street and bounded as follows. Being one hundred and three and one half feet more or less upon Richardson Street on the East a front Three hundred and fifty feet more or less with Samuel Menden Lot on the North one hundred and three and one half feet more or less with Vardry McBees Land on the West a back and Three hundred and fifty feet more or less with my lot and with Mrs Waddell's lot on the South

Together with all and singular the Rights Members Accoutinments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alexander Greenfield his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against any other person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
