of said Ga and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred  
and twelve dollars to me paid by William H Campbell of the  
Town of Greenville in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained  
sold and released and by these presents do Grant, bargain all  
and release unto the said W<sup>m</sup> H Campbell all that tract or  
parcel of Land lying situate and being in the District above nam-  
ed on the White Horse road and Brushy Creek about three miles  
and a half miles from the Town of Greenville by said road and  
bounded by lands of V. M. Bee John W. Towny A. Williman and  
others being the tract purchased by the said Fountain Beattie  
from one Elizabeth Gordon and having the following metes  
and boundaries Beginning at a Hickory tree on the White  
Horse road (I A Towny corner) Thence along said road S 31° 26' 14"  
to a Stake 34 on said road Thence S 88° 29' 24" to a Post O. 34 x 34 " Thence S 36°  
53' 39" to Brushy Creek at the G & C H Road where it crosses said creek  
thence along the meander of said Creek to a Poplar 34 on Thence S 88° 10'  
33" to the beginning containing fifty one acres be the same more or less

Together with all and singular the Rights Member Hereditament  
and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging in any wise incident or  
appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular the premises  
before mentioned unto the said W<sup>m</sup> H Campbell his heirs and assigns  
forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators  
to warrant and defend before all and singular the said premises unto the
