I now all men by these presents that I do C
Montgomery of the State and District aforesaid

for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty five dollars
to me in hand paid by Ernoch Cunningham of the same State and District
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given, granted, bargained
sold and released and by these presents do give grant, bargain, sell release
and convey unto him the said Ernoch Cunningham a certain tract or parcel
of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina in the District
of Greenville aforesaid on the waters of Saluda River about fourteen miles
from the Town of Greenville and bounded as follows "W^E Beginning at
a Red Oak tree corner running thence S 24° W 12 chains 50 links to a maple
tree thence S 16° E 12 chains 85 links to a Spring, thence S 13½ E 6 chains 15
links to a poplar 3⁴ thence S 14° N 6° E 7 chains 14 links to a poplar 3⁴ thence
S 16° W 27 chains 34 links to a Stake 3⁴ thence N 73° W 22 chains 92 links to a
stake thence N 29° E 4 chains 43 links to a pine on Head thence
S 87° E 10 chains 92 links to a rock 3⁴ thence E 77° W 11 chains 60
links to a Black Gum on branch thence down the meanders of said
branch in a north west course about 63 chains to a Stake on the bank of
the branch thence N 36° E 7 chains 67 links to a large poplar 3⁴ thence
N 65° W 17 chains to a Stake and further thence N 39° E 38 chains to a
maple dead and gone in at a Stake in its place on W^E side line thence up
an old ditch in a South East direction about 12 chains to a rock in said branch thence
South 3 chains 25 links to a red oak 3⁴ thence East 34 chains 37 links to the beginning
of a oak 3⁴ containing over hundred and sixteen acres to the same more
or less.

Or other with all and singular the rights, members, headments
and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular the rights, members,
headments therunto appertaining with him the said Ernoch Cunningham his
heirs and assigns forever And the said C C Montgomery do hereby
bind myself by my executors and administrators and assigns forever
to warrant and defend the above granted premises unto him the said Ernoch
Cunningham his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and
against any and every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the
same or any part thereof.
