Beginning on a Water Oak, S x O, thence S 27° 39' E 110 thence N 14° 6' 77' 75 to a stake S x O, thence N 15° West 57.50 to a stake on the branch thence up the meanders of said branch to a Pine S x S x O, thence N 64 1/2° W 142 to a stake on the rail road, thence S 30° E 57.14 to a stake down the rail road thence S 50.10° E to a stake in the forks of the road, thence S 17 1/4° E 22.70 to an angle down Walden Ferry road, thence S 61° 19' 10 to a stake on N Garrison's line, thence N 13° 6'
