Tilmor Stone To 581 Catharine Stone	Deed For Land	Know all men by these presents that I Tilmor Stone of the State of South Carolina Spartanburg District of the one part Catharine Stone of the other part Both of Spartanburg District South Carolina Witnesseth for an in consideration of the sum of six hundred Dollars in hand paid by the said Catharine Stone of the said Tilmor Stone the receipt whereof doth acknowledge hath granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said C Stone a certain plantation or tract of Land lying and being in the said State and in Greenville District on both sides Gap Creek waters of Saluda containing Two Hundred and fifty acres more or less Beginning on a Chesnut running N 33 E 52 chains a wickory thence S 8 E 26 to a pine thence South 40 E 34.50 across the creek to thence thence South 49 W 72 to a stake thence a crop the creek N 50 W 24 first station to gather with all the woods waters & water courses thence commencing as appertaining hereditaments whatsoever thence to belonging here and to hold the said tract of Two Hundred and fifty six or less acres and all and singular the premises thereby unto the said Catharine Stone her heirs and assigns forever for ever and I the said Tilmor Stone warrant & forever defend the above said premises against my self my heirs and assigns even person or persons what soever witness whereof I the said Tilmor Stone have her unto set my hand and affixed my seal this the 4th day of April A D 1836 Signed sealed & Delivered Tilmor Stone presents of G W Newton & Wm Willis
