 To Thomas W Roe For Greenville District
 Land

Know all men by these presents that
 James Roe legatee of the Estate of
 Thomas Roe Senr deceased of the aforesaid State and District
 for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and
 fifty Dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged have granted bargain sold and relin-
 quished my claim unto Thomas W Roe and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell and relinquish unto the said Thomas
 W Roe his heirs and assigns for ever all my interest in
 the Lands belonging to the Estate of Thomas Roe Senr Deceased
 containing Two Hundred and seventy nine Acres it being
 the place where on the said Thomas Roe Senr lived and died
 and being in two separate tracts the One conveyed by William
 Kenyon and the Other by Joseph Heeden to the said Thomas
 Roe Senr deceased recently Surveyed and platted by W. D.
 Hurdfield showing all the marks and boundaries of said Land
 Together with all and singular the right members heredit-
 aments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any
 wise incident or appurtenant. To have and to hold all
 and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas W Roe
 his heirs and assigns for ever, And I do hereby bind
 my self my heirs Executors or administrators to warrant
 and for ever defend all and singular the said premises
 unto the said Thomas W Roe his heirs and assigns against
 my self my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 this 20th January 1835
