Know all men by these presents that I Martin McArnold of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina

in consideration of Four thousand two hundred and twenty five Dollars to me paid by Robert B Arnold of Laurens District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Robert B Arnold all that plantation or tract of land containing four thousand and twenty five acres more or less situated in the District of Greenville lying on the South fork of horse Creek waters of Reedy River beginning on a Hickory 3/4 on said creek running thence S 47 1/2 W 57.50 to a white Oak 3/4 bounding on Samuel L Maddoxes thence N 70 W 41.00 to a sweet gum 3/4 thence S 62 W 4.00 to a stake 3/4 thence N 28 W 33.75 to a small Beach 3/4 thence N 48 E 7.40 to a Stake 3/4 bounding on L McShumate thence S 29 1/2 E 27.40 to a Rock 3/4 thence S 48 W 13.40 to a Spanish Oak 3/4 thence S 13 E 13.25 to a Stake 3/4 on a branch thence down the meanders of said branch to the creek thence down the meanders of said creek to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Robert B Arnold his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Robert B Arnold against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
