 these presents have granted bargained sold and released out by these

 piece parcel and tract of Land lying and being in Greenville District
 on the waters of Brushy Creek adjoining lands Warren Walker & Ethel Holtz
 Law John Howell and Nancy Brown et al containing One hundred
 and six acres more or less beginning on a pine thence N 61 1/4 E 62.10 to Red
 Oak thence N 79 1/4 E 9.42 Stake corner thence S 79 1/4 E 11.75 No. C thence S 1 1/4
 W 81.10 P. O. 3 + one thence S 79 1/4 W 33.70 P. O. thence N 54 W 9.96 P. O. thence S 4 1/4
 W 9.18 thence N 11 1/4 W 15.08 P. O. thence N 61 1/4 E 6.25 P. O. thence N 76 E 10.61 Stake
 corner thence N 53 E 7.41 Maple down thence N 50 E 5.25 to pine the beginning
 corner. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
 or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said Aldridge Green his heirs and assigns
 forever. and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators
 to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the
 said Aldridge Green his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and
 against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
 part thereof. Provided always nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning
 of the parties to these presents that if the said David W Green his heirs exec
 utors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto
 the said Aldridge Green the sum of six hundred dollar according to
 the notes above mentioned then and from thenceforth these presents shall be
 utterly null and void. anything herein contained to the contrary thereof
 in any wise notwithstanding. and it is covenanted and agreed upon
 between the parties to these presents that until default shall be made
 in payment of the aforesaid sum as before set forth and the interest for the same
 it shall and may be lawful to and for the said David W Green peaceably
 and quietly to hold use occupy possess and enjoy all and singular the premises
 above granted and released and every part thereof with the appurtenances
 and to have receive take the rents issues and profits thereof to his own
 particular use and behoof. anything herein contained to the contrary
 thereof in any wise notwithstanding. In witness whereof the said parties
