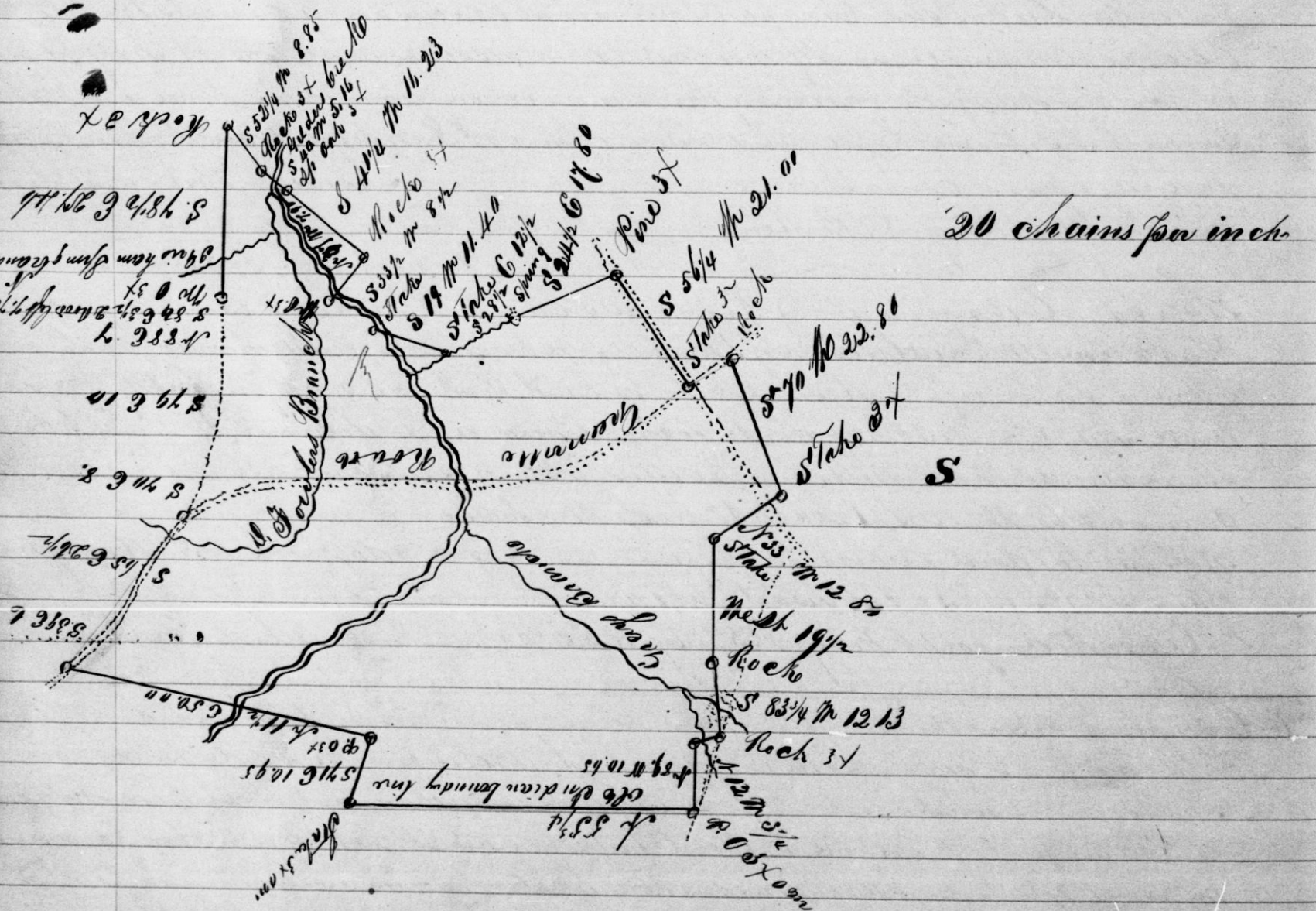

these presents do grant bargain and sell and release unto the  
said John Campbell a certain lot or parcel of land lying and being  
in the district of aforesaid beginning on a post oak running S 76 E 4  
to chains to a stake at the stone thence N 43 W 7.33 ch to a post oak  
thence S 8 1/2 E 6.35 ch to the beginning corner containing by estimat  
ion One acre and One fourth more or less it being a part of  
a tract of land deeded to Randal Barnett by Martin Oats to him  
and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto  
the said John Campbell I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors  
administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the above premises  
unto the said John Campbell his heirs executors administrators &  
assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and against any person  
or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part of the same in witness  
whereof I set my hand and seal of this 1<sup>st</sup> December 1856 Signed sealed  
and delivered in presents James Barnett

when I now live containing sixty three acres more or less lying  
and being in said District on the waters of South Tyger river adja  
cing lands of James McKinney William McKinney J. M. Thumion  
and Nancy McKinney For the purpose of securing a certain  
promissory Note made payable to the said Mary Taylor for the sum  
of Four thousand and sixty dollars & 50 cents bearing date January  
the twenty ninth One thousand eight hundred and fifty seven  
due at twelve months with interest from date. Together with all
