 oak thence S to the conditional line and chestnut between Howard
 and Pittman thence E a long the road to a chestnut thence to the
 Spring branch thence the meanders to a beech on the creek thence
 to a chestnut thence to Spanish oak on the conditional line made
 Henry Baits to Kunchen Walcombe thence to a birch on the
 creek thence to a locust thence to the beginning corner I hereby bind
 my self my heirs executors and assigns for ever the right members
