 of Habeas Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas
 held for the District of Greenville tested the twenty third day
 of March in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred
 and fifty four at the suit of James B Betts and others against
 Charles B Roberts Obediah A Pickle George W Green & Robert
 W Bailey Merchants trading under the firm and style of Roberts
 Pickle and Company to me directed commanding me that of the
 goods and chattles lands and tenements of Charles B Roberts Obediah
 A Pickle George W Green and Robert W Bailey to levy the sum of
 One thousand Six Hundred and eleven dollars and forty two cents
 and also interest on the sum of Eight Hundred and five dollars
 and sixty one cents from the fourth day of January one thousand
 eight hundred and fifty four and also the sum of Seven dollars
 & Sixty two & a half cents for cost and disbursements. I have seized and taken
 of the lands and tenements of the said Charles B Roberts all that
 certain piece parcel & tract of land or town lot containing two
 acres situate & being in the District of Greenville & Village of Green-
 ville & State of South Carolina Beginning at a Stake 34 near the Dun-
 combe Road W. B Thompsons corner & running thence along or near
 said Road S 77 E 20 8 1/2 feet to a Stake 34 thence S 63 W 41 1/2 to a Stake
 34 thence N 37 W 20 8 1/2 to a Stake 34 on said W. B Thompsons line thence
 with said W. B Thompsons line N 33 E 41 1/2 feet to the beginning containing
 two acres more or less as above stated. Together with all and
 singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances
 to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
 appertaining and whereas the said Premises with their appurtenances
 since the seizure by me made by Virtue of the said Writ of
 Habeas Facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at public
 Vendue & purchased by Allen McFarlow Esqr for the sole use and
 benefit of Mrs Catharine J McKay until she becomes a naturalized
 citizen of the United States and then to convey the said premises
 unto the said Catharine J McKay in fee simple for the sum
 of Two thousand Five Hundred Dollars being the highest

sum that was bidde therefor. Now know ye that I William A
 McDaniel Sheriff aforsaid by Virtue of the said Writ of Habeas Facias
 aforsaid to me directed and directed as aforsaid and by Virtue
 of the Statute in such case made and provided for and in
 consideration of the said sum of Two thousand Five Hundred dollars
 to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Allen Mc-
 Farlow Esqr of Chesterfield District South Carolina the receipt and
 payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto
 the said Allen McFarlow his heirs and assigns forever the said
 tract piece & parcel of land or town lot with its appurtenances and
 all the estate right title and interest which the said Charles
 B Roberts of right had of in and to the same. To have & to hold
 the said piece parcel and tract of land or town lot with its appurten-
 ances unto the said Allen McFarlow his heirs and assigns for the
 sole & separate use behoof and benefit of Mrs Catharine J McKay
 formerly of Cheraw & now of Greenville who is a foreigner by birth
 until she avails herself of the act of congress providing for the natu-
 ralization of Foreigners & becomes a naturalized citizen of these
 United States and then in trust to convey all & singular the said
 premises above mentioned unto the said Catharine J McKay and
 her heirs and assigns forever and in case the said Catharine J
 McKay should die without becoming a naturalized citizen of the
 United States and without having disposed of her interest in the
 said premises above mentioned by deed will or otherwise then in
 Statute to convey the said tract of land or town lot to the next
 of kin or that who would be her heirs at law provided she was a
 Naturalized citizen and in case the Catharine J McKay should depart
 this life without being naturalized according to the acts of congress
 and should in her life time have disposed of or directed by deed
 or will or other writing how the said tract of land or her interest
 in it should be vested then in trust to convey the same to such
 person or persons as shall be designated as above stated by the
 said Catharine J McKay and the said Allen McFarlow is to
 have and to hold the said premises above described for the use
 and purposes above mentioned he and his heirs as fully and
 absolutely as if the said William A McDaniel Sheriff of
 Greenville District might could or ought to grant bargain
 and sell the same by Virtue of the Statute aforsaid and
 the said Writ of Habeas Facias or otherwise
