 farming tools and it hath been agreed by and between the
 aforesaid parties that the said Lurana Jenkins shall after the
 said intended marriage is consummated hold retain use employ
 and enjoy all of the aforesaid property to her own sole separate use
 and behoof and benefit during her natural life free from the debts
 contracts or liabilities of the said Joseph W^m Garrison and at the
 death of the said Lurana Jenkins all of the aforesaid property
 of every description with the increase thereof shall be the absolute
 property in fee simple of the said Joseph W^m Garrison. Now this
 indenture Witnesseth that in pursuance of the above recited
 agreement and in consideration of the sum of Five dollars the
 said Joseph W^m Garrison of the first part hereby agrees to and with
 the said Lurana Jenkins of the second that she the said Lurana
 Jenkins shall after the intended marriage is consummated and comple-
 tited and for the term of her natural life hold retain possess
 use and enjoy all of her aforesaid property to her sole and separate
 use and benefit free from the present or future debts contracts
 or liabilities of the said Joseph W^m Garrison during her natural
 life. And the said Lurana Jenkins of the second part in
 pursuance of the before recited agreement and in consideration
 of the sum of five dollars hereby agrees to and with the said Joseph
 W^m Garrison that the said Joseph W^m Garrison shall at the death
 of the said Lurana Jenkins be the absolute owner in fee simple
 of all of her aforesaid property of every description and the

 dollars to me paid by *W^m Lee Thurston* & *Charles J Hammond* of the
 District & State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the
 said *W^m Lee Thurston* & *Charles J Hammond* all that lot or parcel
 of land lying situate & being in the corporate limits of the town of
 Greenville in the District & State aforesaid near the fork of the Anderson
 & Pendleton roads beginning at a Stake on the Pendleton road and
 running thence S 86° 25' 28" poles on line of land formerly belonging
 to Sandy Walker to a small Black Gum 34 thence N 86° 6' 32" poles
 to a Stake thence N 18° W 25.28 poles to a Stake on the Pendleton road
 & thence S 68° W 6.32 poles along the Pendleton road to the beginning corner
 as will more fully appear by reference to the plat attached to the
 deed of said land which was made by Maria S^m Hammond to William
 Choice bearing date the Tenth day of July One thousand eight
 hundred & forty eight containing One acre be the same more
 or less the above described lot being the one sold by the said
 W^m Campbell at public auction on sale day last preceeding
 the date of this instrument, as Trustee for the benefit of certain
 creditors of *Obad A Pickle* & conveyed to the said W^m Campbell
 as Trustee aforesaid by the said *Obad A Pickle* by deed bearing
 date the 25th day of March One thousand eight hundred & fifty four
 and recorded in the office of the M.C. for Greenville District aforesaid
 in Book 2e Pag. 122. Together with all and singular the right mem-
 bers hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging
 or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have to hold, all and
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said *W^m Lee Thurston* & *Charles
 J Hammond* & their heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself and
 my heirs executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend, all and singu-
 lar the said premises unto the said *W^m Lee Thurston* & *Charles J Hammond*
 and their heirs & assigns against my self & my heirs & against every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
