Whereas the General Assembly of the State aforesaid on the nineteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three ratified and act entitled an act to authorize the Superintendent of Public Works to dispose of certain lands belonging to the State by which act the said Superintendent is authorized and directed to sell at public Auction to the highest bidder such lands as are connected with the public Works and not necessary thereto belonging this State at such times and places as he may deem fit giving due notice thereof by public advertisement. And whereas the said Superintendent pursuant to the act aforesaid after having duly advertised the said Tracts for sale by public outcry on the seventeenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four did then openly and publicly and according to the customs of Auctions sell and dispose of a certain tract or parcel of land being one of the tracts aforesaid containing one hundred and eighty four acres more or less hereinafter more particularly described unto the said Govan Mills for sixteen dollars and fifty six cents being at that price the highest bidder for the same.
