I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the foregoing property unto William Bridwell his heirs Executors and administrators against my self my heirs and against any and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof from thought or under me

Charlotte a girl twelve or thirteen year old John a carpenter, thirty two or three years of age. Charles a house servant about forty years of age. Grace a woman about twenty three or four years old. and Matilda a girl six or seven years old. the above named negroes seven in number are the property of Franklin Talbert. Robert a carpenter fifty years of age. Grace a cook about fifty years of age. Rose a house servant about twenty years of age James a boy about four years of age. John a bricklayer about twenty five years of age. the above five named negroes are the property of John J Henry. also all the household and Kitchen furniture sold by P W Chick & R S Chick with the Chick Springs Hotel or whatever furniture may be added hereafter for their like use by Franklin Talbert and John J Henry aforesaid. to have and to hold all and singular the said property together with the future increase of the negroes unto the said Pettus W Chick & Reubin S Chick their Executors administrators and assigns forever. Provided nevertheless and it is expressly agreed between the said parties that if the said Franklin Talbert and John J Henry their Executors Administrators or assigns shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Pettus W Chick and Reubin S Chick their attorneys Executors administrators or assigns the sum of Fifteen thousand Dollars on or before the first day of January next with interest thereon from the first day of January Eighteen hundred and fifty seven then the above bill of sale and every article and thing therein contained shall cease and be utterly void or else remain in full force and virtue, dated in Greenville this the first day of July Eighteen hundred and fifty seven
