This indenture made the Ninth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven between Samuel A Towns Esquire Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville C. H. in the said State of the one part and Robert B Duncan of the other part. Whereas Asa Hodges and wife on or about the day of in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven exhibited their bill of complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville C. H. in the said State against Robt Chick Trustee & Co. And the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at Chambers in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven (1857) when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order adjudged and decree that the lands prayed to be sold in said Bill should be sold at Public Auction by the Commissioner of the said Court on the terms of and for the purposes mentioned in their decretal order as by reference thereto in the Registry of the said Court will appear and the said Samuel A Towns as Commissioner of the said Court after having duly advertised the said Lands for sale by Public Outcry on the 6<sup>th</sup> of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and 57 did then openly and publicly and according to the custom of Auction sell and dispose of the said Lands or Lot below described unto the said Robert B Duncan for Twenty One Hundred dollars being at that price the highest bidder for the same. Now therefore this indenture witnesseth that the said Samuel A Towns as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of Twenty One hundred Dollars paid him by the said Robert B Duncan the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said Robert B Duncan heirs and assigns all that Lot of land Situate in the Village of Greenville Beginning at a Stake corner on Buncombe Street & running N 21 6 with the R B Duncan's lot formerly J G Duncan lot three hundred and forty eight feet (348) to Academy Street thence N 70 W a Long Academy Street Five hundred & sixty two feet (562) to a Stake corner on Buncombe Street thence along the said Buncombe Street to the beginning containing about Two acres more or less Being the same Lot of Land conveyed to Burwell Check by Vardry McBee & dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of
