Whenas William Hew deceased late of Greenville District did execute his last will and Testament which said will was proven before the Ordinary of Greenville District in accordance with the act of the Legislature of South Carolina The said will bequeath unto his two daughters Rachel and Malinda three negro slaves viz to his daughter Rachel two girls named Jane and Abigail and to his daughter Malinda a girl named Emily which bequest was to continue during the natural life of his said daughters Rachel and Malinda and at their death the said slaves and their increase were to be equally divided between the brothers and sisters of the whole blood of the said Rachel and Malinda Hew Now in order to secure to the said Rachel Hew and Malinda Hew and absolute right in the three slaves above mentioned Now know all men by these presents that in pursuance of the premises aforesaid and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars to us in hand paid by Rachel Hew and Malinda Hew we the said Benjamin Hew Ephraim Hew Ignatius Hew Matilda Weaver and John Weaver her husband Elizabeth Jenkins Susannah Kendrick Celia Keese and A J Keese her husband Lavina Shockly and John P Shockly her husband Mary Walker and John Walker her husband have bargained sold released and relinquish and by these presents do bargain sell release and relinquish unto the said Rachel Hew and Malinda Hew all our right title interest and claim unto the said negroes slaves Jane Abigail and Emily either in law or Equity which were bequeath in the will of William Hew deceased unto his two daughters Rachel and Malinda during the natural lives and at their death to be equally divided amongst us sisters and brothers of the whole blood. To have and to hold all and singular the said slaves Jane Abigail and Emily and their future increase unto the said Rachel Hew and Malinda Hew and their heirs and assigns and we the said Benjamin

Hew Ephraim Hew Ignatius Hew Matilda Weaver and John Weaver her husband Elizabeth Jenkins Susannah Kendrick Celia Keese and A J Keese her husband Lavina Shockly and John Shockly her husband Mary Walker and John Walker her husband do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executor and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said relinquishment unto the said slaves Jane Abigail and Emily and their future increase to the said Rachel Hew and Malinda Hew their heirs and assigns against ourselves our heirs and assigns and no further.
