W. 44. ch 50 Links to a Stake 37 bounded by Jas. Reeses and Micajah Berry Lands, thence S 60 W 27 50 to a Stake 37 bounded by M. Berrys Land, thence S 20 E 17 to a Stake 37 thence S 20 W 13. to a Pine bounded by Amos Askins Land thence C 38 chains to the beginning 37 On Original Line. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the Premises above described unto the said Th^r Hopkins his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the Premises above mentioned, unto the said Thomas Hopkins his heirs and assigns forever against myself and my heirs and assigns and every person whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any Part thereof; Witness my hand and seal this 20th day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred & fifty Seven

Our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and fifty seven between William H. Ashmore of the One Part and Dr. J. A. Permitt of the Second part both of the District and State aforesaid. Witnesseth that whereas the said William H. Ashmore is desirous to make provisions for his daughter Laurenda Frances Wells of the state and district aforesaid against future contingences and for her use and benefit and whereas the said William H. Ashmore is desirous that his said daughter should enjoy the Boy Anderson and a girl Malinda hereinafter named more particular described during the term of her natural life then to the heirs of her own body free from the liabilities or disposal of any husband she may ever have and provided my said Daughter should die leaving no natural heirs of her own body then in that case the said negro with their increase to fall back into my estate to be equally divided between my surviving heirs Now therefore this indenture witnesseth that the said William H. Ashmore in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to him Paid in hand by the said Dr. J. A. Permitt the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto the said J. A. Permitt Trustee One negro Boy named Anderson about eleven years of age and also One negro girl Malinda about six years old together with their future increase of said girl Malinda together with all and singular the said negroes with her increase unto the said J. A. Permitt his successors and assigns Interest for the several uses intents and purposes hereinafter mentioned, namely First Interest to Put therein the possession of my said daughter to serve her as she may desire or wish second interest to sell the said boy and girl or any of their increase if desired and Lay out the money for others to be held in the same manner as above mentioned in Trust.
