 Know all men by these presents that I Jacob Reese of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by Amos Tollison of the said District and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Amos Tollison a small tract or parcel of Land lying in the State and District aforesaid on the waters of Keedy Fork of Keedy River being part of a tract of Land known as the Greener Land and conveyed through several person to the said Jacob Reese and now from the said Jacob Reese to the said Amos Tollison containing fifty Acres be the same more or less Beginning at a Stake 34 on the side of a road and near the creek on the said Jacob Reese line thence running S 35 E 5 1/2 to a stake 34 thence S 35 W 5 1/2 to a Stake 34 thence S 82 E 3 1/2 to a Stake 34 on Dr. James Carrisons line bounded by the said Jacob Reese land thence N 40 W 38 1/4 to a Stake 34 bounded by Dr. James Carrison thence S 35 W 20 to the Beginning bounded by said Reese.
