aforesaid and also for divers other good causes and consideration
me the said William Barton hereunto moving have given granted
and confirmed and by these presents do give grant and confirm
unto the said Thomas Barton a certain negro Girl about fifteen
year old and has put him in possession of her by delivering her
to him by name Mariah at the time of sealing and delivering
of these presents with the exceptions of me the said William Barton
having the use benefit and profits of her labor during my lifetime
or till I think proper to give her up to the said Thomas Barton
then at the expiration of either of those terms then the said Thomas
Barton is to have and to hold all and singular the Inceasue benefits
profits advantages and income of the above mentioned negro in wha
ever possession she may be found unto the said Thomas Barton
his heirs executors administrators and assigns unto the only
proper use and behoof of the said Thomas Barton against me the
said William Barton my heirs Executors administrators and assigns
and all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and will war
rant and forever defend by these presents the above above mentioned

causes and consideration I the said William Barton Sen hereunto
moving have given granted sold and confirmed and by these
presents do give grant sell and confirm unto the said William
Barton Senor a certain Negro Girl about thirteen years old
and has put him in possession of her by delivering her to him
by name Martha at the time of sealing and delivering of these
presents, also a certain Negro boy for a consideration of the sum
of Two hundred dollars about three year old and has put him
in possession of him by delivering said boy to him by name Giles at
the time of sealing and delivering of these presents, with the exception
of me the said William Barton Sen having the use benefits and
profits of their labor during my lifetime or till I think proper to give
them up to the said William Barton Junr my son then at the expiration
of either of these terms, then the said William Barton Sen is to have
and to hold all and singular the Inceasue benefits profits advantages
and income of the above mentioned negroes in whatsoever possession
they may be found unto the said William Barton Sen his heirs
executors administrators and assigns unto the only proper use
and behoof of the said William Barton Sen against me the said
William Barton Sen my heirs Executors administrators and assigns
and all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and will
warrant and forever defend by these presents the above mentioned
negroes unto the said William Barton Sen, In witness whereof
