356 Wm Martin Deed of Trust Georgia Lumpkin County This indenture made this first day of March 1858 between William Martin of one part and William P Price and his wife Martha A H Price of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which the said William Martin bears towards his daughter the said Martha the said William Martin has given granted and conveyed and does by these presents give grant & convey unto said William P Price a certain negro girl named Nora about fourteen year of age for the use purposes and trust hereinafter named to wit Use purpose & trust first To have and to hold said negro slave and her increase during the life of said Martha for the use and maintenance of said Martha and the maintenance & education of such children of the said Martha as may hereinafter be born during the life of said Martha use purpose and trust second To have and to hold said negro girl slave and her increase during the life of said William P Price for the purpose of maintaining said William P Price during his life but nothing herebefore or hereafter contained in this deed shall be so construed as to subject said negro girl or her increase to the payment of any debt which said William P Price may now owe or may

hereafter owe Nor shall said William P Price mortgage or convey said negro girl or any of her increase on any pretext whatever. Use & purpose & Trust third in the event said Martha shall survive her said husband William P then said negro girl and her increase to go to said Martha during her life to be used and applied as indicated in the aforesaid use purpose & trust first aforesaid Use purpose & trust fourth after said William P and Martha shall both have departed this life then said negro girl and her increase to go to the lineal descendants of said Martha according to the laws of inheritance now of force in the State of Georgia and should there be no such descendants of said Martha then said negro girl and her increase to go to said William Martin his heirs and assigns forever. With a view to a distinct understanding of the intention of this deed it is reiterated said girl and her increase shall remain in the joint possession of said William P and Martha A H Price during their joint lives and in the possession of the survivor during the life of such survivor not subject to any debt or lien of said William P or Martha or any conveyance of either of them and after the death of both of said William P and Martha then the possession to go to the descendants of said Martha as before stated and on failure of there being any such descendants to go to said Martin his heirs and assigns as before provided.
