bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said David Devenport
all that tract or parcel of land situate lying & being
in Greenville District on both sides of Middle Fork
of Saluda River & on both sides of Middle Saluda Turn
pike Road containing Fourteen Hundred & Twenty
nine acres according to the Grant of the same signed
by His Excellency Governor W B Mc Allston Seventeenth
day of March Eighteen Hundred & fifty seven and
surveyed by John C Hoyt D S December 29th 1856 and
and thath such shapes & Boundaries as set fourth in said
Plat & Grant reference being had to the same for a more
perfect & full description of the said Land. Together
with all and singular the rights members & hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all

and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
David Devenport his heirs and assigns forever and I do
humbly bind my self my heirs executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said David Devenport his heirs and
