Perry assignee of James W Sherman the entire stock in trade of James W Sherman amounting to Twenty Seven hundred and sixteen dollars and fifty three cents and consisting of Stoves tin and iron ware agricultural implements pumps oils tools furniture fixtures and other matters and things which are set forth in a schedule accompanying a deed for the same from said W. H. Perry to said C I Olford, and whereas said Charles I Olford is desirous of carrying on the same business which has hitherto been carried on in Greenville S.C. by said James W Sherman and previously by Sherman Brothers and whereas the said Charles I Olford cannot carry on the said business in person by reason of other engagements but must employ some other person to carry on the same as his agent Now this agreement witnesseth that the said Charles I Olford hath employed the said James W Sherman as his agent to carry on the said business in all its various branches at such stand as said Charles I Olford may furnish at Greenville S.C. for the purpose and this purpose hath placed the said stock in trade &c in possession of the said James W Sherman as agent aforesaid for the purpose aforesaid, and the said Charles I Olford may from time to time hereafter as the exigencies of the said business may require increase and add to the said stock in trade the title

and ownership thereof remaining and being in the said Charles I Olford and the said James W Sherman undertakes and agrees to carry on the said business as agent of the said Charles I Olford in a faithful and economical manner, and to render an account of the same from time to time as he may be required, The said Charles I Olford is to superintend the financial affairs of said agency and to have the Books kept and collections made. No orders for stock or materials are to be made or notes signed except by C I Olford and the said Charles I Olford in consideration of the premises aforesaid agrees to pay to the said James W Sherman one half of the profits which may be realized from the said business in remuneration of the services of said James W Sherman as agent as aforesaid therein after deducting the necessary expenses incident to carrying on the same
