 Know all men by these presents that Sarah Dill of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar to me in hand paid by Kunnels Dill my beloved husband I do hereby give and release and by these presents do give and release unto the said Kunnels Dill a certain tract or parcel of Land lying in Greenville District on the head waters of South Syger river being half the tract I now live on of which said half is to embrace the west end where I now reside bounded by lands of Jesse Trammell Wilson Trammell and others the same to contain fifty Acres more or less (Reserving the same for my own use and benefit during my own natural life). Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or in anywise incident to the same. To have and to hold all and singular the above described premises unto the said Kunnels Dill his heirs Executors and administrators for ever I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above named premises unto the said Kunnels Dill his heirs or assigns forever against my heirs or any other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed seal this Twenty second day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight.  This agreement made and entered into the Fifteenth day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty eight between Lewis Huff of Greenville District in the said State of the first part Eliza Caroline Huff his wife of the second part and Gideon B. Thomason Trustee of the third part witnesseth. Whereas unhappy difference have arisen between the said Lewis Huff and the said Eliza Caroline Huff his wife and whereas in consequence thereof they have mutually agreed to live separate and apart from each other and whereas the said parties have agreed together upon the stipulations and arrangements hereinafter set forth for the separate support maintenance and alimony of the said Eliza Caroline Huff and for her full and perfect discharge and release from any further and other claim charge or interest in the real and personal estate of the said Lewis Huff and for the other purposes hereinafter expressed. Now this agreement witnesseth the in consideration

of and in pursuance of the purposes above expressed and in consideration of the sum of Five dollars to the said Lewis Huff by the said Gideon B. Thomason Trustee paid. It is hereby solemnly agreed by and between the said Lewis Huff and Eliza Caroline Huff that they will henceforth live separate and apart from each other, and for the purpose of providing for a full sufficient and satisfactory support maintenance and alimony for the said Eliza Caroline Huff by the said Lewis Huff doth hereby for himself his heirs executors and administrators covenant agree and bind himself to and with the said Trustee his heirs executors and administrators that he the said Lewis Huff will pay to the said Gideon B. Thomason Trustee the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars, payable in ten equal and successive annual instalments with interest. The first of which shall be due and payable on the first day of January next. The said Gideon B. Thomason Trustee to have hold and receive the said sum of Fifteen hundred dollars and every part thereof as the same may become due and be paid to him, in trust for and to the sole separate and exclusive use and benefit of the said Eliza Caroline Huff and to pay the same over to her for her own purposes and behoof. and the said Lewis Huff for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth further covenant agree and bind himself to permit and suffer her the said Eliza Caroline Huff from time to time and at all times from henceforth during her natural life to live separate and apart from him, and to reside and be in such place and places, and in such family and families, and with such relations friends and other persons, and to follow and carry on business as a feme sole trader, at her will and pleasure, without molestation let hinderance or responsibility, on the part of the said Lewis Huff and the said Lewis Huff for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth further covenant agree and bind himself that he will never take claim demand or receive any of the moneys goods chattels clothes or other matters of any kind whatsoever hereafter acquired by the said Eliza Caroline Huff, but will always suffer the said Eliza Caroline Huff to have hold use possess and enjoy the same for and during the term of her natural life free from any demand control contract and debts of the said Lewis Huff and that upon the death of the said Eliza Caroline Huff all the property of every kind soever which the said Eliza Caroline Huff may then be possessed of shall vest and go according to a testamentary appointment to be made by her in the nature of a last will and testament, or to her own kindred and relations, according to the Statute of distribution if she die without making such testamentary appointment, and it is further agreed by and between the said parties in consideration of the foregoing premises that the said Eliza Caroline Huff doth hereby fully and entirely release let free and discharge the said Lewis Huff from any further liability or obligation for her support and maintenance henceforth and that she doth hereby accept of the sum of Fifteen hundred Dollars to be paid as aforesaid as a full sufficient and satisfactory provision for her future support and maintenance, and it is further agreed by and between the said parties that the said Eliza Caroline Huff doth hereby renounce release and relinquish all claim of dower or inheritance, of in or to any
