 all her interest and legacy or devise under the said Will to her
 children the heirs at Law & legatees of the said Henry B Prince
 for & in consideration of a support & maintenance of her by her
 said children & the use of a negro woman & other property during
 her life. and when as the said heirs legatees & devisees of the said
 Henry B Prince now agreed amongst themselves to divide out
 at once amongst themselves all the real & Personal Estate of the
 said Henry B Prince subject to partition & division on the death
 of his widow the said Peggy Prince. Now Know all men by these
 presents that we Baylis C Prince William F Prince Jasper F Prince
 Albartus M Prince Sonora A Goodlett Soprona C Cunningham
 & her husband John W Cunningham the heirs at Law Legatees and
 devisees under the will of our Father the late Henry B Prince
 & assignees of the interest of our mother Peggy Prince under the
 said will do covenant and agree with each other jointly and
 severally as follows. The whole of the Personal property left in the
 will to be divided at the death of Peggy Prince amongst us equally

 Secondly the parties to this covenant & agreement are to contribute

 during her life time so that she shall be well provided for according
 to arrangements hereafter to be entered into & agreed to for with the
 consent of their said mother. They are also to let their said
 mother have during her life to wait on her one negro girl
 named Mary & also the use of a bed & furniture. This negro girl
 & her increase if any together with the bed & furniture to be sold
 at the death of the said Peggy Prince & the proceeds equally divided
 amongst us as the other property now sold to be according to
 the directions of the will. It is further agreed that the executor

of the said will Jasper F Prince do act as our gent in selling the said
 property & making partition of the same according to this contract and
