 second part and to his heirs and assigns forever all that parcel or
 tract of land situate in State and District aforesaid bounded by
 B F Page on the west and Allen M David on the south and on the
 east by J B & J L Williams and on the north by Austin Williams
 containing fifty eight acres together with all and singular the
 Tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging
 or in anywise appertaining and the reversions and reversionary
 remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and
 also all the estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever
 as well in law as in equity of the said party of the first of in and
 to the same To have and to hold the above granted and descen-
 ded premises with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second
 part his heirs and assigns to his and their own proper use and
