H. near the road leading from Greenville to Batesville Factory on the waters of rocky creek being part of the same tract conveyed by Edmond Miller to Israel Miller & by him to Archibald Miller & from him back to the said Israel Miller Bounded East by Willis Laffo on North by John Watson by Archibald Millers on the west then on Edmond Miller to beginning corner beginning at a rock S60 W 2.25 to a stake 3+ thence S 29° E 49.20 to a stake 3+ in a swamp or dry branch thence S60 W 10 to a stake 3+ N 80° E 35 to a stake 3+ thence N 10 W 38 to a stake in the road leading from John Watsons to Greenville C.
