 bounds as by reference to a Plat annexed to the conveyance of
 John A Leland Superintendent of Public Works to John S Lewis bearing
 date the seventh day of July A D One thousand eight hundred and
 forty four recorded in the Office of the Register of Meise Conveyance
 for said District in Book U Page 419 & 420. 13 September 1844

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident
 or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said William Thompson his heirs and assigns
 forever and do hereby bind heirs executors and administrators to

 whereof is hereby acknowledged at and before the sealing and delivering
 thereof. I have given granted bargained sold conveyed and confirmed
 and by these presents do give grant bargain sell convey and confirm
 unto my said two sons as before named jointly a certain negro boy
 named Ransom about sixteen years of age to have and to hold the
 said negro boy as aforesaid to them jointly their heirs and assigns
 for ever and in the event that either die without issue then the
 survivor to be the sole owner of the said negro if the one dying leave
 issue then that issue to take jointly with the survivor and in the
 event both my said sons die leaving no lawful issue then the said
 negro boy shall return to my heirs at law equally the said negro boy
 Ransom is now in my possession and is to remain and to be subject
 to my control and management during my will and pleasure.
